I hereby request and voluntarily accept membership in the Aurora Education Association, Colorado Education Association, and National Education Association, and agree to abide by the Constitution and Bylaws of all three associations. I hereby authorize the Aurora Education Association to deduct the above amount monthly from my salary for the dues required for membership in these associations. Such deductions shall be in the amount of one-twelfth (1/12) of said annual dues and shall be made from my monthly salary payments for each month that I shall be entitled to receive salary payments from the school district.
